Please indicate the positions for which you would like to be considered:

- Resident Fellow** for academic year: maximum 2 page curriculum vitae; maximum 2 pages addressing the selection criteria.
- Resident Assistant** for academic year: maximum 1 page curriculum vitae; maximum 1 page addressing the selection criteria; only these two pages will be considered in your application. Interviews will be on Saturday 10 October.
- Summer Duty Resident:** available only to resident staff in 2009 or those selected as resident staff for 2010. Other than ticking the box, no further application is required.

Positions may be filled on the basis of a written application only. In some instances, a list of successful applicants will be kept by the college for employment as it becomes available.

Applications should be addressed to the Principal and submitted to the Office no later than 12 noon on Tuesday 6 October 2009. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
